First-time positives on employer drug tests

Employees in safety-sensitive positions

DWI Referrals

Individuals who are resistant to treatment

Motivational strategies and standardized drug and alcohol assessment tools are used in therapeutic workshops to educate and increase awareness of the personal consequences of continued usage.
